## **UPDATE – Asphalt resurfacing on K-10 to begin July 6**

### **Pavement overlay projects in Douglas County to begin Monday**

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, a mill and overlay project on U.S. 40, in Douglas County, will begin, Monday, June 15, weather permitting. Work will occur from just east of the Shawnee/Douglas County line, east to the K-10 junction and is expected to be completed mid-July.

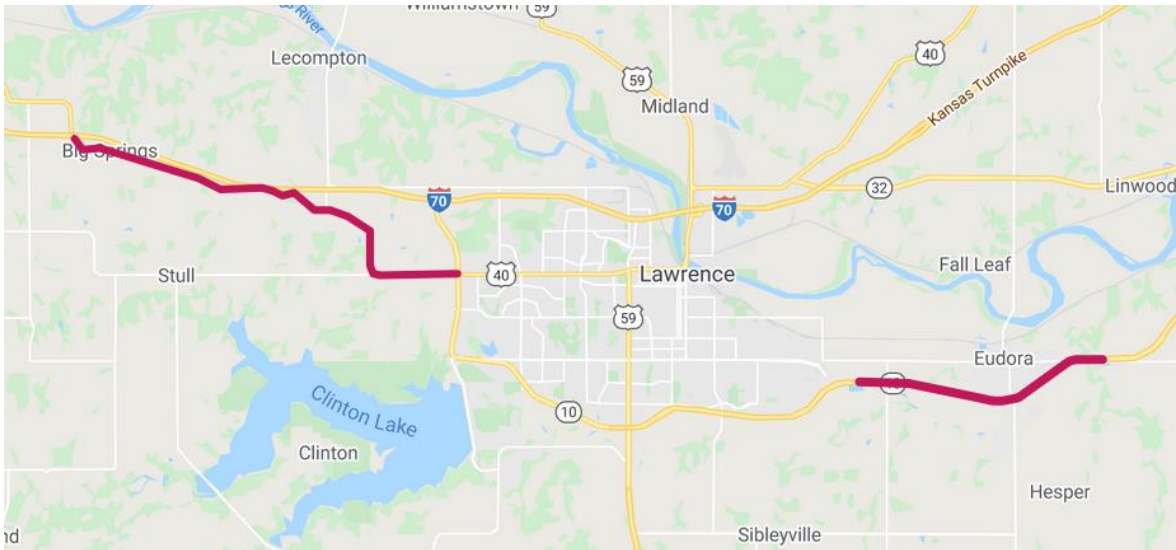
In addition, an asphalt resurfacing project on K-10, in Douglas County, is expected to begin, Wednesday, July 1, weather permitting. Work will occur from one-half mile west of E-1900 Road, east to the Douglas/Johnson County line, and is expected to be completed mid-August.

Work on both projects will happen during daylight hours. Traffic control will include a lane width restriction of 12 feet in the work area, a pilot car operation, traffic cones and signage. Motorists should expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

Hamm, Inc. of Perry, is the contractor on the \$1.7 million and \$1.2 million projects, respectively.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction
