Lighting work to close westbound lane of I-70 on the Polk Quincy viaduct in Topeka

Kansas Department of Transportation crews will provide traffic control for a lighting project on I-70 on the Polk Quincy viaduct in Topeka, Tuesday, June 30, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

The westbound lane of I-70 on the Polk Quincy viaduct at mile marker 362 will be closed while the alert lights are worked on. Motorists should expect slow moving traffic and delays in the area.
