Concrete patching on I-70 continues

Kansas Department of Transportation maintenance crews have closed the right lane of westbound I-70 from the 4th Street off ramp to the 2nd Street on ramp in Topeka for concrete patching.

The lane closure will shut down the 2nd Street on ramp from Topeka Boulevard during work hours. The 4th Street off ramp from I-70 will remain open during the project. The lane reduction could last up to two weeks to allow the concrete to cure, weather permitting.
