
Bridge inspections and guardrail maintenance close lanes

Kansas Department of Transportation crews will be performing bridge inspections on the U. S. 75 Westgate bridges in Topeka on Wednesday, June 17, through Friday, June 19, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting

This work will close the inside passing lane, reducing U.S. 75 to one lane in each direction from Lower Silver Lake Road south to the I-70 interchange.

Crews will also be repairing the guardrail on I-470 from the I-470 westbound ramp that extends to I-70 eastbound on Thursday, June 18, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. The lane will remain open, but motorists should expect slow moving traffic and delays in the area. Update: Work has now been extended through Friday, June 19, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
