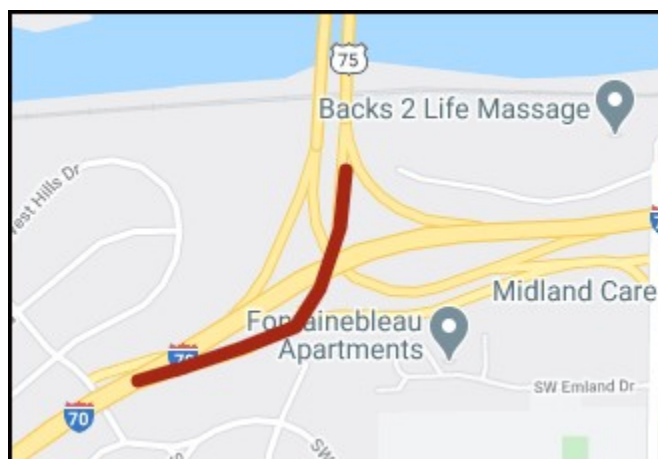

I-70 guardrail repair scheduled in Topeka on Oct. 6

The Kansas Department of Transportation will be repairing guardrail on the interchange ramp from I-70 eastbound to northbound U.S. 75 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 6, weather permitting.

The work on the guardrail will take place on the left shoulder and on the right of way area off the road. No lanes will be reduced, but maintenance vehicles and personnel will be in the area and motorists are encouraged to use extra caution.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of road construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.org. Drive safely and always wear your seat belt.
