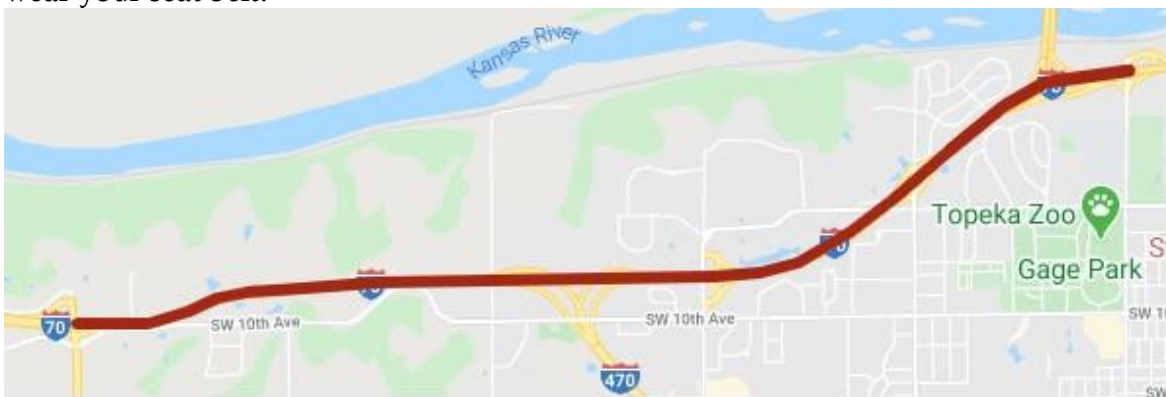

Maintenance work on eastbound I-70 in Topeka

Eastbound I-70 from K-4/Auburn Road to Gage Boulevard in Topeka will have intermittent lane reductions on Thursday, July 23, and Friday, July 24, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting. The lane reductions are necessary as Kansas Department of Transportation crews will be brooming the barrier wall and flushing wall drains and bridge decks.

The 5-mile mobile operation from mile markers 353 to 358 will have attenuators and arrow boards to direct traffic. Please use caution and expect slow moving traffic.
