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
Mill and overlay project on U.S. 24 to begin Monday

A mill and overlay project on U.S. 24 in north Topeka will begin, Monday, May 11, weather permitting. Work will occur from approximately mile marker 363 to mile marker 367, east of Northwest Menoken Road to west of the U.S. 24/Northwest Rochester Road intersection and is expected to be complete by the end of June.

Traffic will be controlled with daily lane and ramp closures as necessary, using traffic cones and signage. Motorists should expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

Bettis Asphalt and Construction, Inc. of Topeka is the contractor on the \$1.6 million project.
