Overhead sign work on I-70 in Topeka to begin April 12


According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, contractors are expected to begin overhead sign work involving lane closures on Monday, April 12, on I-70 in Topeka.

Crews will be replacing overhead signs from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on the following days, weather permitting:

- Monday, April 12 Right lane will be closed on westbound I-70 from Croco Road to Adams Street.
- Tuesday, April 13 Right lane will be closed on westbound I-70 from Adams Street to 1st Street.
- Wednesday, April 14 Left lane will be closed on westbound I-70 from Croco Road to Adams Street as well as the eastbound left lane from Adams Street to Croco Road.

Traffic will be controlled using standard signage and cones. Please use caution and expect slow moving traffic.
