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Bridge repair over I-70 in Shawnee County to begin March 8


A bridge repair project over I-70 at the Southeast Croco Road junction in Shawnee County to begin March 8, weather permitting.

Work will occur one half hour after sunrise to one half hour before sunset and the project is expected to be complete mid-June.

Southbound bridge traffic will use a signed detour and a lane width restriction of 12 feet in the work area for northbound traffic. Lane closure and detour will remain in place 24 hours a day from the start of the project until it is complete. Traffic will be directed using signage and traffic cones.

Bettis Asphalt & Construction, Inc. of Topeka is the contractor on the \$202,300 project.
