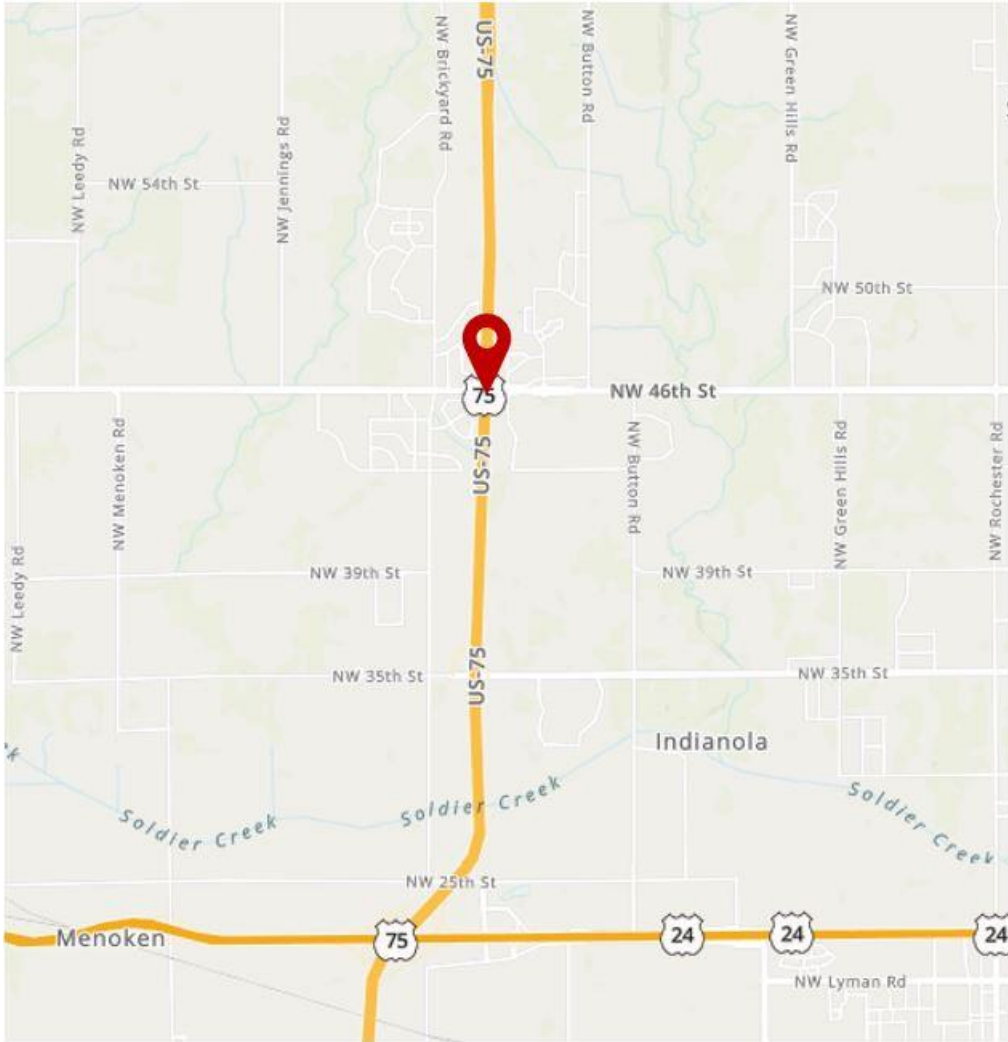

U.S. 75 guardrail maintenance scheduled in Topeka next week

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT), maintenance crews will complete guardrail maintenance along southbound U.S. 75, around the N.W. 46th Street exit, in Topeka next week. Work will take place on Monday and Tuesday, Dec. 6 and 7, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

On- and off-ramps will remain open, but southbound U.S. 75 will be reduced to one lane while crews are working. Drivers should be prepared for slow-moving traffic through the work zone, which will be marked by arrow boards, cones, signage and crash attenuators.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1.
