

## Polk Quincy Viaduct lane reduced on May 6

The right lane of westbound I-70 will be closed from mile marker 361 to 362 on the Polk Quincy Viaduct in Topeka on Thursday, May 6. Kansas Department of Transportation maintenance crews will be patching potholes from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

According to KDOT, the S.E. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street on ramp to I-70 will also be closed during this time. There will not be a speed reduction through the one-mile work zone, and work is expected to be completed the same day.
