Maintenance projects in Topeka this week

The Kansas Department of Transportation will conduct several maintenance projects in Topeka this week, weather permitting.

Tuesday, April 6 – Guard rail repair on westbound K-4 at the Rock Creek Bridge, mile marker 344, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Traffic will be controlled using a flagging operation and traffic can use the eastbound lane for the duration of the project.

Wednesday, April 7 – Patching and brooming the right lane across the Polk Quincy Viaduct Bridge, right lane of westbound I-70 will be closed, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Traffic will use the westbound left lane for the duration of the project.

Thursday, April 8 and Friday, April 9 – Guard rail repair, eastbound I-70, just before Southeast Adams St. off ramp, the bridge over the railroad tracks. The eastbound 10th Street on-ramp and acceleration lane will be closed, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Traffic can use the left lane of eastbound I-70. All lanes and ramps will be open overnight and unfinished work will be blocked off at night.

Traffic will be controlled using signage, traffic cones and a flagging operation when necessary.
