
I-70 lane reductions scheduled in Topeka

The Kansas Department of Transportation will reduce traffic to one lane on eastbound I-70 in Topeka on Monday, Oct. 18, and Tuesday, Oct. 19, weather permitting.

KDOT crews will be patching potholes and retrieving core samples between mile markers 361 and 363. Crews will be working in the right lane on Monday and in the left lane on Tuesday between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Traffic control will include crash attenuators, arrow boards, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should be prepared for slow-moving traffic through the area and use extra caution.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1.
