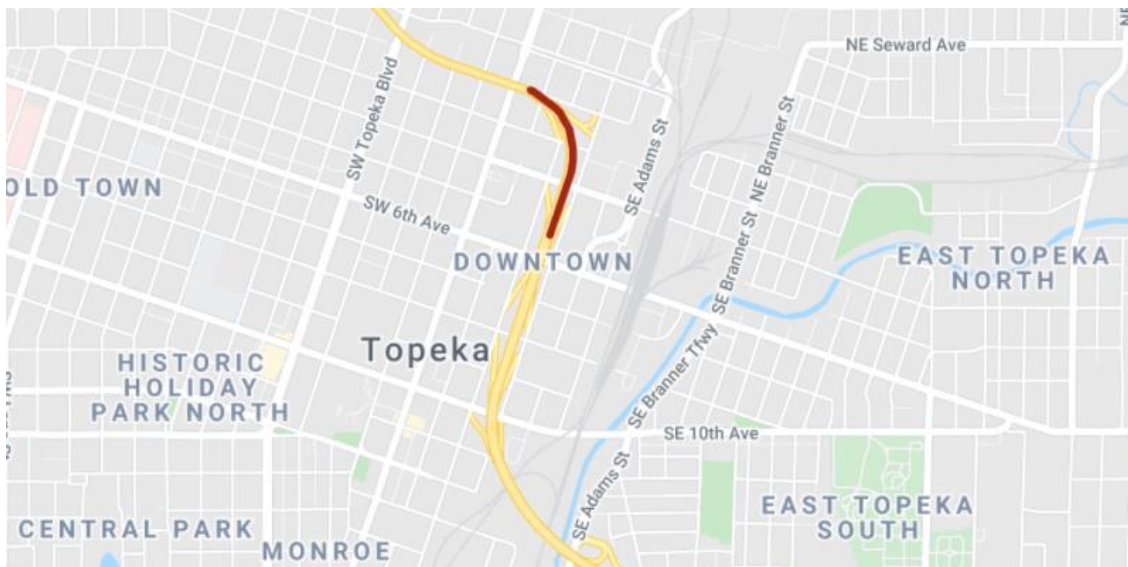

Polk Quincy Viaduct lane reduced on Wednesday

The right lane of eastbound I-70 will be closed from mile marker 361 to 362 in Topeka on Wednesday, Sept. 29. Kansas Department of Transportation maintenance crews will be patching potholes on the Polk Quincy Viaduct from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

According to KDOT, all on- and off-ramps will remain open. Drivers should be prepared for slow-moving traffic through the work zone, which will be marked with arrow boards, signage and cones.
