Survey for proposed bridge replacement on I-470 in Topeka

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) to begin a field survey, Monday, Feb. 1, for a proposed bridge replacement on I-470 in Topeka.

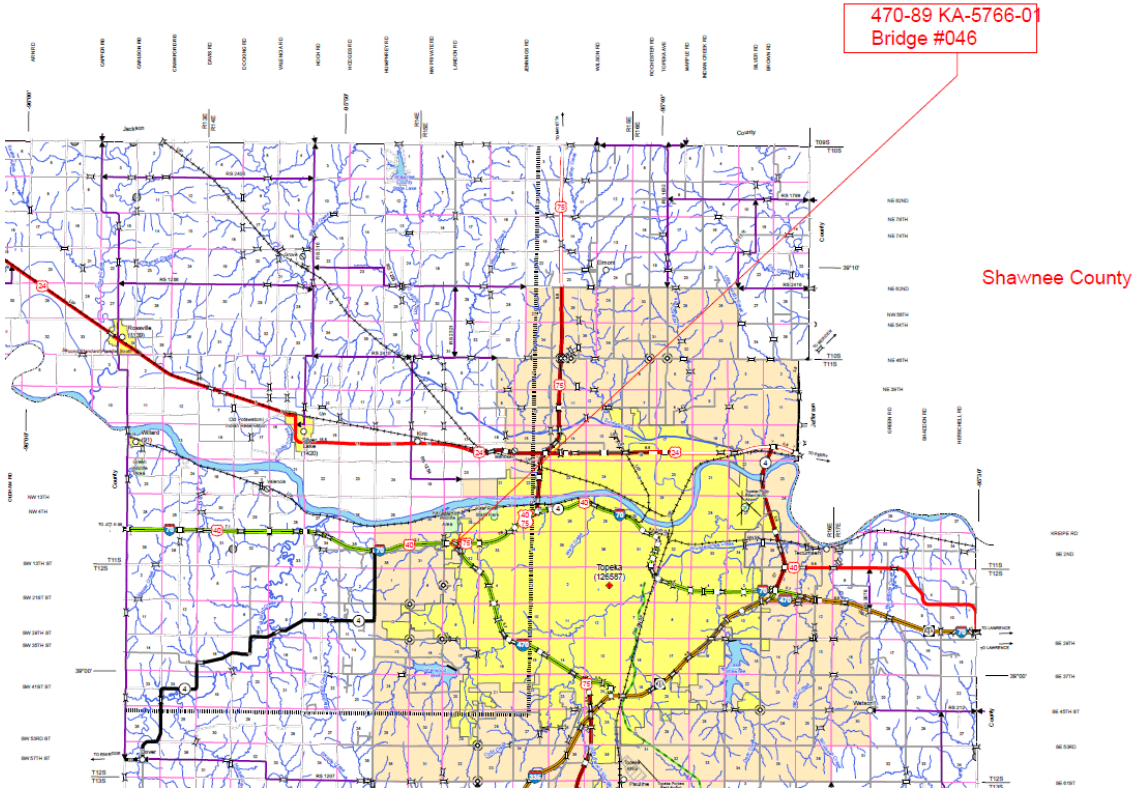
The proposed bridge replacement is located on I-470, one quarter mile northwest of 10th Street.

The survey is to gather information that is necessary for the detailed design of the proposed improvement and is estimated to be completed by March 1, 2021.

Joe Bowen, P.S., Field Survey Project Manager, KDOT, will be in charge of this survey for KDOT.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
