### I-70 lane reductions in Topeka on July 6

Portions of eastbound and westbound I-70 through Topeka will be reduced to one lane on Tuesday, July 6. Kansas Department of Transportation maintenance crews will be patching potholes between mile markers 360 and 363 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

The right or left lane will be closed around the active work area as it moves along I-70. Traffic control around the mobile operation will include crash attenuators, signs and cones. Drivers should be prepared for slow-moving traffic.
