South Lawrence Trafficway public comment period extended

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) are gathering public input on the South Lawrence Trafficway (SLT) Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) Identified Preferred Alternative. The public comment period began April 26. To allow the public additional time to review and comment, the end date is extended from June 21 to **September 30, 2021**.

The draft SEIS Report is available [online](#) as well as at the Lawrence Public Library, City of Lawrence City Hall, Public Works Office and Douglas County Public Works Office until September 30.
