I-70 lane reductions in Topeka June 22 through June 24

Portions of eastbound and westbound I-70 in Topeka will be reduced to one lane from Tuesday, June 22, through Thursday, June 24.

Kansas Department of Transportation maintenance crews will broom debris from the barrier wall between mile markers 353 and 367 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. All work is weather permitting.

The left lane will be closed around the active work area and will move along I-70 as equipment allows. Traffic control around the mobile operation will include crash attenuators, arrow boards, signage and traffic cones. There will also be a speed reduction through the work zone, and drivers should be prepared for slow-moving traffic.
