Public input requested on South Lawrence Trafficway

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) are gathering public input on the South Lawrence Trafficway (SLT) Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) Identified Preferred Alternative. The public comment period began April 26 and will conclude June 21.
