Polk Quincy Viaduct lane reductions on May 24 & 26

Traffic will be reduced to one lane on the Polk Quincy Viaduct in Topeka on Monday, May 24 and Wednesday, May 26. Kansas Department of Transportation maintenance crews will patch potholes on the right lane of westbound I-70 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Monday and crews will repair fencing and patch potholes on the right lane of eastbound I-70 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Wednesday. All work is weather permitting.

Traffic control will include signage and traffic cones. There will not be a speed reduction through the work zone and the I-70 on and off ramps will remain open. Drivers should be prepared for slow-moving traffic through the work zone.
