
U.S. 24/N.W. Rochester Road intersection improvements May 24

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, intersection improvements will occur at U.S. 24 and N.W. Rochester Road in Topeka on Monday, May 24. Maintenance crews will paint turn lane lines from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m., weather permitting.

Sections of the intersection will be closed to left-turning and through traffic in 15-minute intervals. Traffic will be able to make right turns at the intersection for the duration of the project.

The work zone will be marked with signage and traffic cones. Flaggers may also be used to direct drivers.
