U.S. 75 bridge inspections scheduled in Topeka next week

Crews from the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will complete bridge inspection work on U.S. 75 in Topeka next week from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting. Motorists should plan for the following:

- **Monday, Aug. 29** – The right lane of northbound U.S. 75 will be closed between I-70 and the Lower Silver Lake Road exit.
- **Tuesday, Aug. 30** – The southbound U.S. 75 overpass to eastbound I-70 will be reduced to one lane. The eastbound I-70 exit to northbound U.S. 75 will also close around 10 a.m. for approximately one hour. Traffic will be detoured to Gage Blvd., then to westbound I-70, then to northbound U.S. 75 while the closure is in place.

Drivers should prepare for slow-moving traffic through the work zones, which will be marked by arrow boards, cones and signs.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of road construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1.
