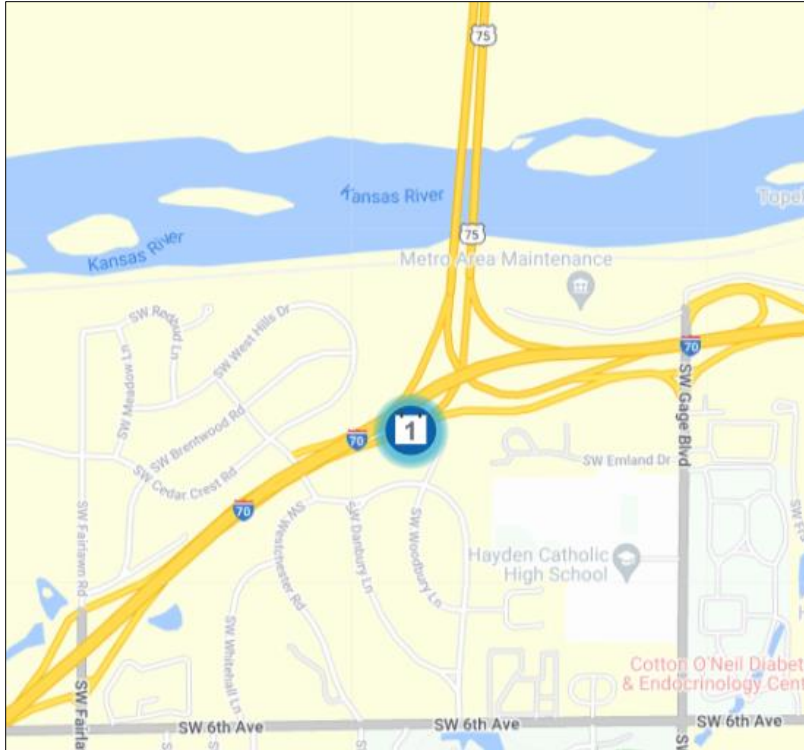

## **I-70/U.S. 75 exit ramp closure scheduled in Topeka**

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT), the eastbound I-70 exit onto northbound U.S. 75 in Topeka will close temporarily while crews complete pothole repairs. The ramp will be closed Friday, April 1, from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m., weather permitting. Drivers will be able to use the Gage Boulevard exit during this time.

The closure will be marked by barricades, signs and cones. No marked detour will be posted during this time. Drivers can go north on Gage Boulevard and take the westbound I-70 ramp to get to northbound U.S. 75.
