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Bridge repairs on K-4/Oakland Expressway starting in Topeka


A bridge repair project on the Oakland Expressway (K-4) in Topeka is scheduled to begin Tuesday, July 5, weather permitting. The bridge spans the Shunganunga Creek and is located just north of the K-4/U.S. 40 junction.

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, traffic will be reduced to one lane in the work zone and will be directed by temporary traffic signals. Drivers should plan for delays of up to 15 minutes.

Work will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Traffic signals will be in place for the duration of the project, which is expected to be complete by late November.

PCiRoads of Saint Michael, Minn., is the contractor on the \$607,000 project.
