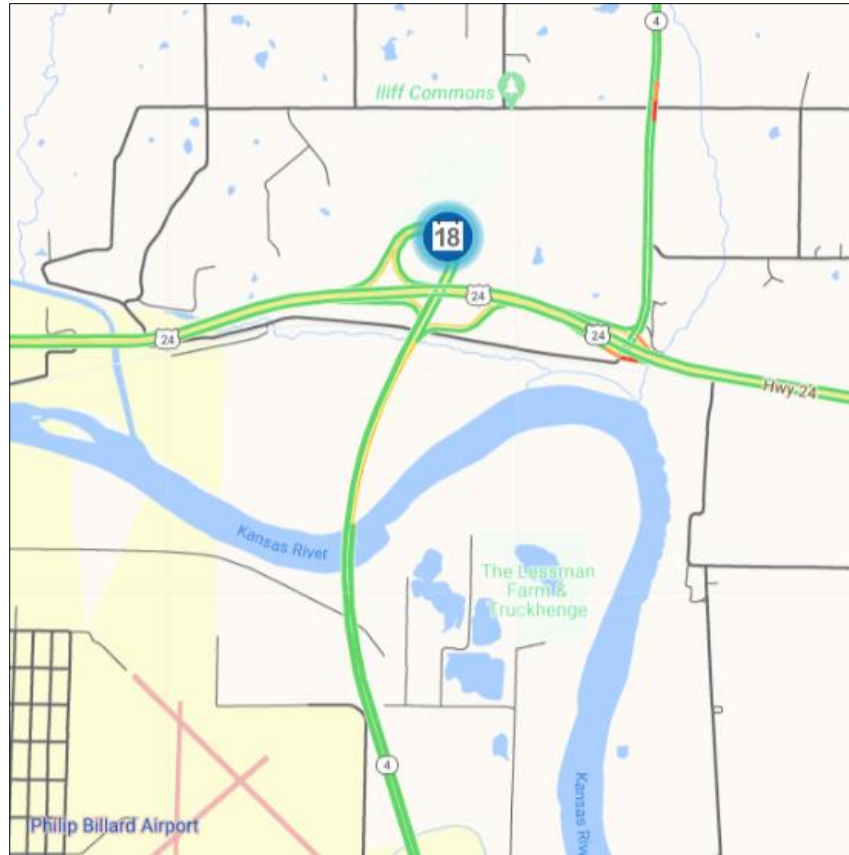

Oakland Expressway/K-4 to be reduced Wednesday

The Kansas Department of Transportation maintenance crews will be completing bridge maintenance work at the north end of the Oakland Expressway (K-4) in Topeka on Wednesday, May 18, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

Alternating lane closures will occur on northbound and southbound K-4, at the westbound U.S. 24 entrance and exit ramps. Flaggers will direct traffic through the work zone, which will be marked by signs and cones. Drivers should plan for delays of up to 10 minutes.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1.
