SW Huntoon Street lane closures scheduled Thursday in Topeka

The Kansas Department of Transportation maintenance crews will be conducting I-470 bridge inspections on SW Huntoon Street, between SW Wanamaker Road and SW Arvonia Place, in Topeka on Thursday, May 19, weather permitting.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane eastbound and one lane westbound on SW Huntoon Street, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. The eastbound SW Huntoon Street left turn on-ramp to I-470 will be closed for short periods of time as necessary.

Signs, cones and arrow boards will mark the active work zone. Delays should be minimal, but drivers should be prepared for slow-moving traffic through the area.
