South Lawrence Trafficway Record of Decision Posted

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) have approved and released the Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) and Record of Decision for the South Lawrence Trafficway (SLT) project.

For the past four years, KDOT and FHWA have been evaluating the benefits and impacts of potential improvement options for the SLT. They have posted the Final SEIS on the project website.

The public may download and review copies of the document and appendices at <https://slt-ks.org/slt-final-seis-documents>. The formal Notice of Availability (NOA) for the project documents was published in the Federal Register on April 1, 2022.

The SEIS evaluated options for improving the SLT, including review of reasonable alternatives that will enhance safety and improve congestion while supporting its use as a thriving corridor for the City of Lawrence and the surrounding region.

Final design will begin immediately with construction anticipated to begin in 2024.
