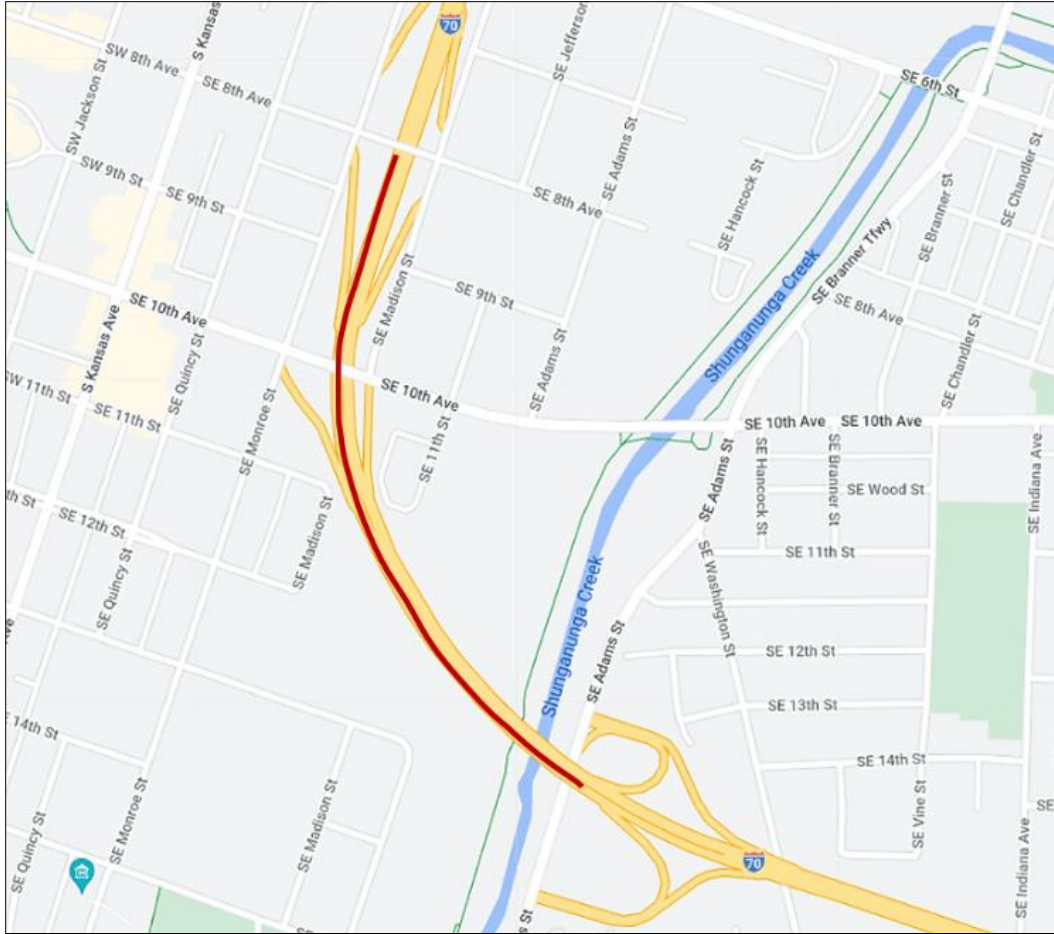
## **Eastbound I-70 lane reduction planned in Topeka**

Beginning Wednesday, Nov. 8, the Kansas Department of Transportation will reduce a portion of eastbound I-70 in downtown Topeka for additional bridge repair work.

Eastbound I-70 will be reduced to one lane from approximately 8<sup>th</sup> Street to Adams Street. A 12-foot width restriction and reduced speed limit will also be in place through the work zone. On- and off- ramps are expected to remain open.

Drivers should prepare for slow-moving traffic and minor delays. Conditions permitting, work should be complete by the end of November.
