Ramp closures scheduled tonight, tomorrow morning in Topeka

The Kansas Department of Transportation has scheduled temporary ramp closures to occur tonight and early tomorrow morning on I-70 and U.S. 75 in Topeka. Motorists should plan for the following:

As part of the I-70 resurfacing project, the following ramps will close temporarily, but not simultaneously, tonight, Sept. 5, between the hours of 6 p.m. and midnight. Each closure will last approximately 3 hours:

- The eastbound I-70 exit ramp to eastbound I-470.
- The eastbound I-70 exit ramp to Wanamaker Road.

As part of the southbound U.S. 75 flyover bridge repair project, the following ramps will be closed early tomorrow, Sept. 6, from 1 a.m. to 4 a.m.:

- The eastbound I-70 exit ramp to northbound U.S. 75.
- The southbound U.S. 75 exit ramp to eastbound I-70.

Message boards and signage will be in place to alert and direct motorists.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of highway construction projects across Kansas, go to www.KanDrive.gov or call 5-1-1.
