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U.S. 24 construction information now available online

The Kansas Department of Transportation has posted new informational materials online related to the ongoing U.S. 24 improvements project in north Topeka and Jefferson County. The new documents, including a project fact sheet and construction phasing timeline, can be viewed on the project website: <https://ike.ksdot.gov/us-24-shawnee-county>.

KDOT also plans to host an informational open house this spring, where the public can attend to learn more about the project and meet the project team, as well as learn about other projects that are being planned along Topeka's U.S. 24 corridor. Details of the open house will be shared and posted to the website once scheduled.

The 5.5-mile project on U.S. 24 extends from Kansas Avenue in Topeka to Muddy Creek in Jefferson County and includes full-depth pavement reconstruction, bridge work, and intersection safety improvements. Construction began in July 2023 and is expected to be complete in 2027, conditions permitting.

Koss Construction Co., of Topeka, is the \$64 million project's prime contractor.
