U.S. 24/Meriden Road intersection to close tomorrow

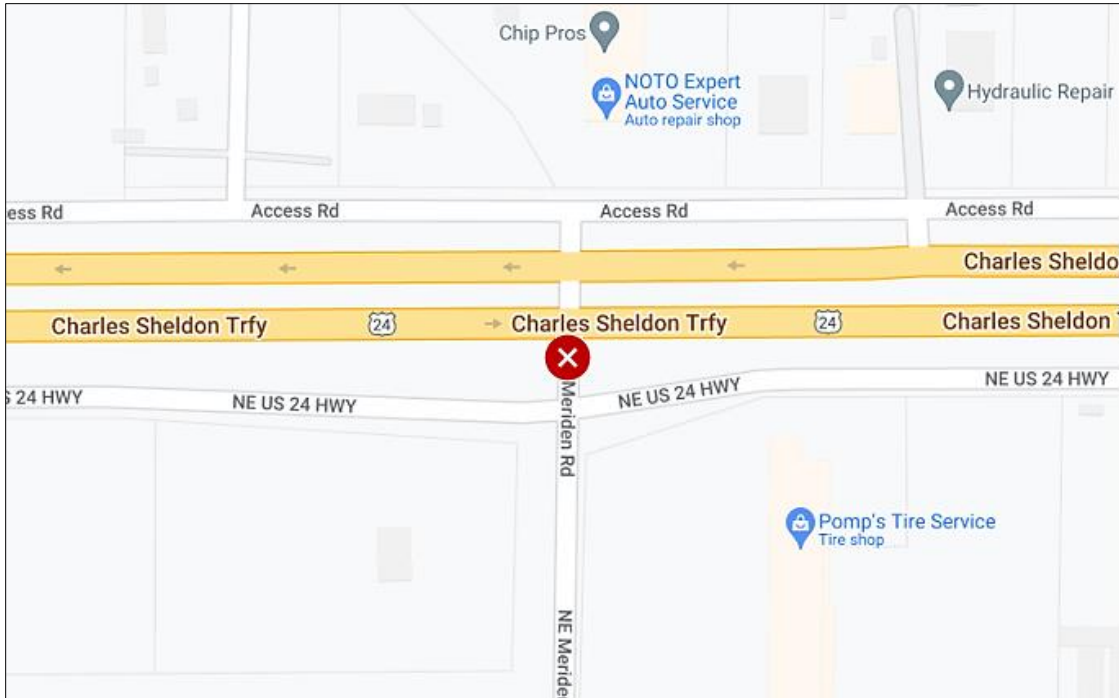
Beginning tomorrow, March 27, the U.S. 24 and south Meriden Road intersection in north Topeka will be closed for pavement work.

The closure is part of the Kansas Department of Transportation's U.S. 24 reconstruction project and is expected to be in place for about 3 weeks, conditions permitting.

Traffic can follow the signed detour on Goldwater Road/Grantville Road/Burgess Avenue and Kansas Avenue or use alternative routes.

Businesses at the U.S. 24/Meriden Road intersection can be accessed from the south.
