U.S. 75/U.S. 24 exit ramps to close tomorrow

Two exit ramps at the U.S. 75/U.S. 24 interchange are expected to close tomorrow morning, as part of the Kansas Department of Transportation's bridge repair project on U.S. 75 in Topeka.

Conditions permitting, the following ramps will close on Wednesday, Sept. 4, at 6:30 a.m.:

- The southbound U.S. 75 exit ramp to eastbound U.S. 24,
- The westbound U.S. 24 exit ramp to southbound U.S. 75.

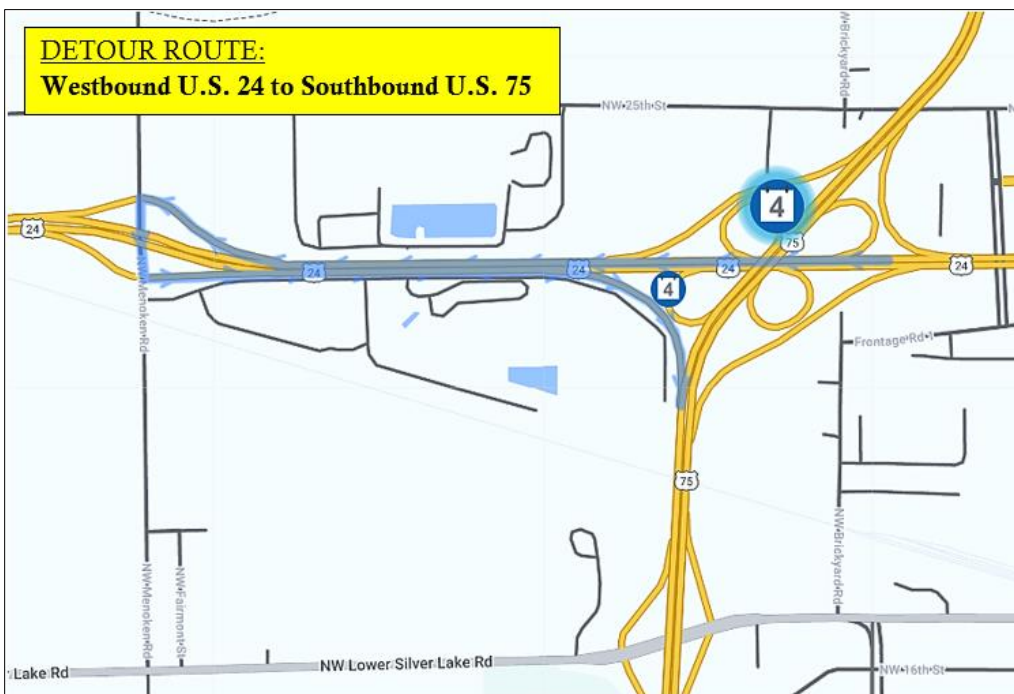
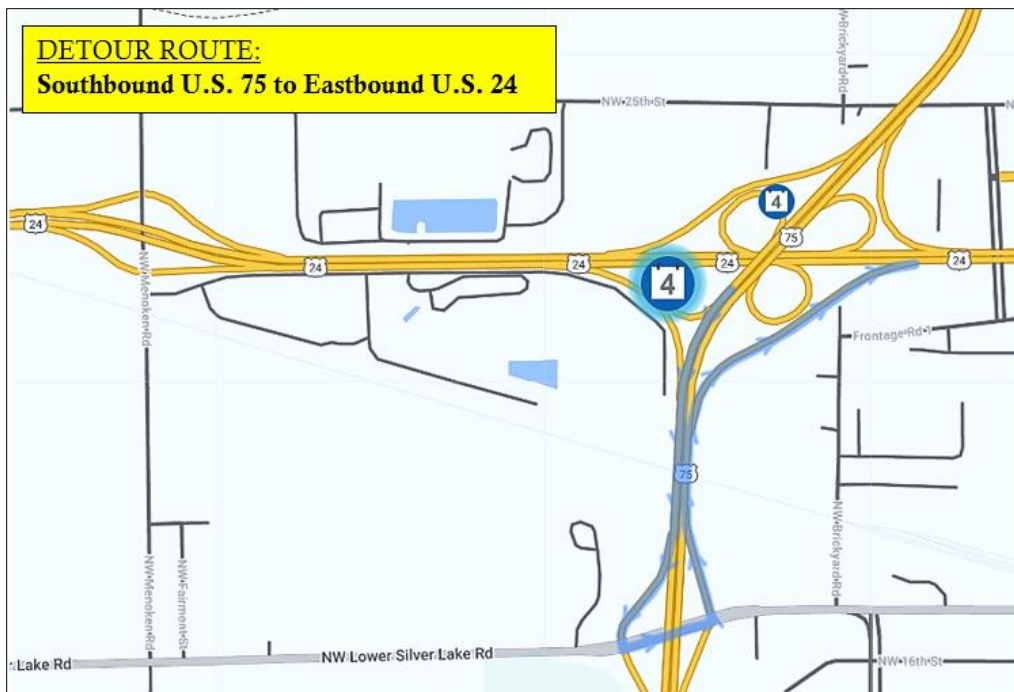
Detours will be marked as follows during these closures, which are expected to be in place until early October:

- Southbound U.S. 75 will be directed to Lower Silver Lake Road, to northbound U.S. 75, to the eastbound U.S. 24 exit.
- Westbound U.S. 24 will be directed to Menoken Road, to eastbound U.S. 24, to the southbound U.S. 75 exit.

Motorists can follow the signed detours or use alternate routes that are not marked. Drivers should plan for delays and are encouraged to use other routes, if possible.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of highway construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.gov or call 5-1-1.
