## U.S. 75 flyover bridge to temporarily close overnight

The temporary closure of an eastbound I-70 ramp in Topeka will take place in the early morning of Wednesday, Aug. 21, so that safety netting can be installed under the structure. The netting is intended to catch potential debris that may fall while chip patching work is completed on the bridge surface during the Kansas Department of Transportation's ongoing repair project.

Conditions permitting, **the eastbound I-70 ramp to the northbound U.S. 75 flyover will be closed from 2 a.m. to 4 a.m.** when traffic counts are lower.

During the closure, motorists should follow the signed detour east to Gage Boulevard, then north to westbound I-70 and back to northbound U.S. 75. Message boards and signage will be in place.
