Dear Mr. Younger:

As requested by Ms. Davonna C. Moore's June 10, 2009 letter, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have reviewed the subject STIP amendment and find it is based on a transportation planning process that substantially meets 23 USC 134 and 135, 49 USC 5303 and 5304, and 23 CFR Part 450. The amendment is approved.

This amendment includes two new KDOT American Recovery & Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funded projects (TIP #ARRA-08-17, #ARRA-08-18) and a number of transit project revisions (e.g. project deletions and additions, revised funding and project descriptions). There are also several non-ARRA funded projects added.

A contingency list of ARRA projects is included in the amendment. Although these projects are unfunded, we are allowing the projects to be in the TIP so the sponsors and KDOT can get these projects "shovel-ready" in case additional ARRA funds become available. If additional funding does become available, the Policy Body will select the projects to be funded. Projects not selected for funding will be deleted from the TIP.


