## FEDERAL LANDS HIGHWAY PROGRAM

---

The Federal Lands Highway (FLH) Program was established to allow for all federally owned public roads to be treated under uniform policies similar to the policies that apply to federal-aid highways. Funding is provided for several categories of Federal Lands highways including Park Roads and Parkways, Indian Reservation Roads (IRR), Public Lands Highways (discretionary and Forest Highways), and Refuge Roads, which provide access to or within the National Wildlife Refuge System. FLH funds may be used for transit facilities within public lands, national parks, and Indian reservations and may also be used as the state/local match for most types of federal-aid highway funded projects.

### **Federal Lands Highway Projects**

Currently, there are no FLH projects under construction or in development in Kansas. If future projects arise during federal fiscal year 2013, the projects will be added to KDOT's FFY 2013-2016 STIP using the amendment process.

### **Indian Reservation Road Projects**

Four Indian Nations have reservations contained or partially contained

within the State of Kansas. These Nations receive federal funding for roads and bridges from the FLH Program. The funds for the FLH program are administered through the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA).
