MARC's Public Involvement Plan requires that proposed amendments to the TIP be released for public review and comment prior to adoption by the MARC Board of Directors. Two comments were received. The comments and responses from MARC are included for your reference.

This amendment is financially constrained and maintains the financial feasibility of the FFY 2016-2020 TIP.

Since the MARC TIP is incorporated by reference, without modification, into the statewide transportation improvement program (STIP), the MARC TIP represents the most current listing of projects within the boundaries of the Kansas City metropolitan planning area and should be the basis for comparison of projects listed in the amendment. In the paper recently was a notice soliciting public comments on some projects MARC is involved in. I clou't use the internet so am bossing my comments on cletails mentioned in that notice as well as matters that I recall MARC being a part of in the past.

First, no message boards on highways. We're bludgeoned by messages and need places where we can be safe from them. Authority already has too many platforms from which to impose

its views.

Decond, curb the enthusiasm for bike paths and lanes. No more "bike route" signs. People should be able to figure out routes for themselves. Don't waste taxpayer money and

earth's resources on signage.

Only in limited instances, really, do lanes need to be marked, such as the major four-lane roads that don't allow porling and in southern Johnson County-like places, with its horrible pattern of huge thoroughfare or deadend cul-de-sac. There it would make sense to harrow the lanes and add a bike lane on the right. Instead of special bike trails, cul-de-sacs ould be annected, creating through-ways for nonmotorized means.

Even worse are dedicated bike paths - the equivalent of relegating bikes to the kiddle pool. It's important that alternative transportation not be swept out af sight, out of mind on the early behalf. Besides, the last thing the earth needs is more pavement to sustain a dual-transportation system. The basic rules of the road provide the necessary

One of the beauties of bikes, skates, feet, whatever, is that they are low-impact means that shouldn't require costly and controlling engineering and regimentation. They demand little from society, a personal solution to problems created by destructive, overestivent technologies. These high-tech, high-power, high-dollar public works make them sust another consumeristic activity and their users Cogs in the machine.

Lastly, if street lighting is up for discussion, I have two comments. First, the amount should be reduced. On the Missouri side of the State line, it is impossible to see all but the brightest stars. Second, LEDs are great for energy use, but need to be softened. Weird as I thought the orange lights there, they're so much better than the sterile, glaring white of the LEDs. No one needs to be cutting diamonds or performing surgery in the streets. Must we chase the night away as though we've never managed to outgrow a childish fear of it?

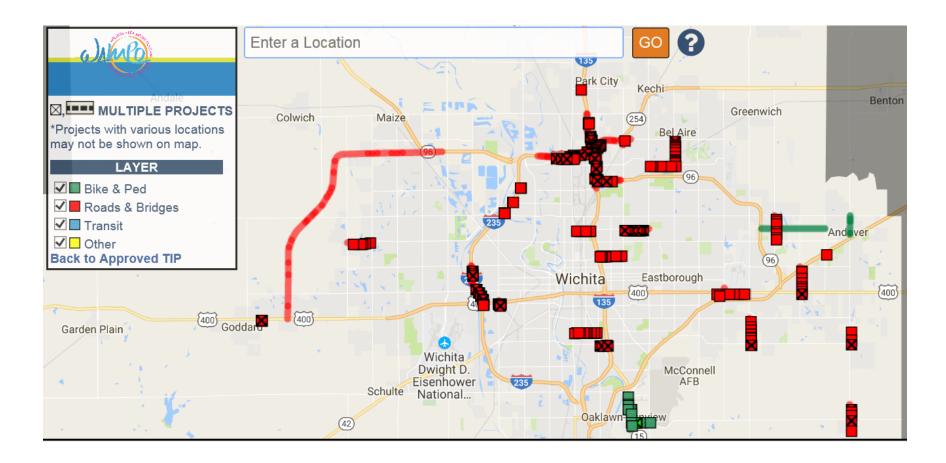

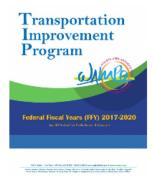
