HOW TO READ THE STIP PROJECT INDEX- APPENDIX A

The project index, Appendix A, lists projects anticipated to have one or more phases or work obligate in the State of Kansas during the four years of the STIP. The index provides all expected obligations- federal, state, local and other. Below is a diagram that identifies the fields provided for the projects listed in Appenidx A.
