### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Topeka Planning Organization (MTPO) is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) to carry out the Continuing, Cooperative and Comprehensive planning program (3C process), including transportation planning; and,

### TIP Amendment #5

2011-2014 TIP # 5, KA-2107-01 (KDOT) I-70 Bridge #043 (Deer Creek Bridge Rehabilitation) —Attached please find the proposed amendment to the 2011-2014 TIP, pertaining to the revision of existing project #KA-2107-01. The scope of this project has changed from a "bridge replacement project," to a "bridge rehabilitation project." This change is only for the engineering phase, and has changed from a 2011 start to a 2012 start. The cost for this engineering phase is now reduced from \$416K to \$400K. Three hundred twenty thousand dollars of these PE funds will be advanced construction (AC) funds which will be converted to federal BRF funds in 2016. Upon conversion, \$80K will remain as state funds. The corresponding fiscal constraint table and project table are attached.
