

# FAQs

- 1) I was previously working on my application, but I came back today and there are no attachments.
  - a. You may have started more than one application. When coming back to work on your application later, click “view” next to your 2026 unsubmitted application instead of applying again.
  - b. If you have started more than one application, you can delete the extras to prevent further confusion.

- 2) Am I in a floodplain?
  - a) Please use the FEMA link to see if you're in a registered floodplain. This should be done once a year as flood plains will change.
  - b) <https://msc.fema.gov/portal/search>
  
- 3) How do I search my SAM registration?
  - a. Type SAM.gov into your URL bar
  - b. Once on the SAM.gov page, click log in. This will take you to the login.gov page. If you do not already have an account, make one now.
  - c. Click on "search" and drop down the "select domain" bar and click "entity information"
  - d. scroll down and make sure you have both active and inactive selected.
  - e. Scroll back up and type in your organization name. You can add KS to the end if you need to narrow the searches and will pull up anything with your organization name that has KS either in the name or address.
  
- 4) How can I get back into my Qualtrics application to make changes.
  - a. Please email the [KDOTtransit@ks.gov](mailto:KDOTtransit@ks.gov) inbox. This will be more effective than emailing Taylor Zortman as anyone in the transit team can see the KDOT inbox and get you a link to your specific Qualtrics application, including Taylor. This means that no matter who is out of the office or in another meeting, you can still get your question answered.
  
- 5) Why is there no back button?
  - a. There are some sections with it, but I think only 1 or 2 because all the conditional formatting I put in messes with the functionality of the back button. Basically, I have too many questions that are hidden or only visible depending on answers to other questions and so the back button does not know where to send you and therefore just removes itself in those sections.
  
- 6) Is a Ford transit a full-size van?
  - a. Yes, they are the same vehicle.
  
- 7) How many seats does a full-size van have?
  - a. At maximum capacity, if no seats are removed for wheelchair spaces, a full-size van can seat 13.
  
- 8) What are the vehicle estimates for SFY 26?
  - a. Ramp Minivan: \$91,500
  - b. Full-size van w/o lift: \$107,500
  - c. Full-size van with lift: \$125,000
  - d. Composite Cutaway (14 or 20 passenger): \$166,000
  - e. Metal Cutaway (14 or 20 passenger): \$183,000
