Mill & Overlay on K-266

The Kansas Department of Transportation began a mill and overlay project on Tuesday, July 16, beginning at the U.S. 36/K-266 junction and continuing north to the end of the route for approximately 7.5 miles.

Construction will take place during daylight hours and traffic will be reduced to one 11' lane following a pilot car through the work zone. Drivers should expect a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

APAC Inc. of Hutchinson is the prime contractor and have scheduled this project to be completed by Aug. 23, weather permitting, at a cost of \$524,000.
