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Surface recycle and chip seal on K-82

On Aug. 28 the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a surface recycle and chip seal project on K-82 from K-15 to U.S. 77 in Clay and Riley counties.

Construction will take place Monday through Friday with occasional Saturday work during daylight hours. Traffic will be reduced to one 15-foot lane following a pilot car through the work zone. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Dustrol Inc. of Towanda is the prime contractor and anticipates this 11-mile project to be completed Oct. 4, weather permitting, at a cost of \$1.1 million.
