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K-4 Mill & Overlay begins May 16

On May 16 the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a mill and overlay project on K-4 from Lindsborg to I-135 at Bridgeport for approximately 4.16 miles.

Traffic will be reduced to one 12' lane during daylight hours with flaggers and a pilot car to move traffic through the work zone. Drivers should expect a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

APAC-Kansas Inc. of Hutchinson is the prime contractor and have scheduled this project to be completed at the beginning of June, weather permitting, at a cost of \$555,918.
