U.S. 54 reopens between Pratt, Greensburg

U.S. 54 between Pratt and Greensburg reopened this afternoon (Thursday, Jan. 30).

The highway section had been closed since Sunday night (Jan. 26) because of a butane pipeline leak near the highway around Cullison, west of Pratt.

During that time, motorists were directed to other routes.

According to Pratt County Emergency Management, the incident has shifted from an emergency response to a cleanup operation involving the pipeline company.
