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\$10.7 million resurfacing on U.S. 54/400 east of Augusta begins soon

Work will start soon on a \$10.7 million resurfacing of U.S. 54/U.S. 400 east of Augusta.

The project – concrete patching and an asphalt overlay – will be from the east city limits of Augusta to east of the junction of U.S 54, U.S. 77 and U.S. 400. The section is 8.15 miles long.


The work is expected to begin between Oct. 12 and Oct. 19 and be completed next summer.

During the work, traffic will be limited to one lane in each direction, and the speed limit will be reduced. Motorists will face minimal delay.

The Kansas Department of Transportation is overseeing the project.

APAC-Kansas Inc., of Hutchinson, is the main contractor for the \$10,759,743 project.
