UPDATED: Survey for proposed replacement of Barber County bridge


A survey is being done for proposed replacement of the Little Mule Creek bridge on K-2 in Barber County.

The proposed replacement is 1.8 miles east of U.S. 281.

The initial survey – needed for detailed design of the proposed bridge replacement -- is expected to take three to four weeks. The survey is based on the existing alignment. Dave Taylor, P.S., Survey Project Manager, CFSE, will be in charge of this survey for the Kansas Department of Transportation.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
