One lane of I-135 in Newton to be affected by work on April 1

One lane on a portion of southbound I-135 in Newton will be affected by maintenance on an overhead sign on Wednesday, April 1.

The speed limit in the work zone will be lowered to 60 mph. Motorists should stay alert and be prepared to slow down -- or stop in limited instances -- in the area affected by the work.

The right southbound lane from Broadway to the bridge over Southeast 14th Street – about a mile long -- will be affected from around 7:30 a.m. to around noon Wednesday.

KDOT is taking advantage of lighter traffic in recent days to do highway maintenance.
