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New, wider K-14 bridge opens south of Kingman


Traffic is now open on the new K-14 bridge at Hunter Creek near Kingman.

The new bridge – about 3 miles south of Kingman -- is higher and wider than the previous bridge and includes drainage improvements.

Work on the bridge replacement began in early June, and the new bridge opened to full traffic on Thursday, Nov. 12.

The Kansas Department of Transportation oversaw the project. King Construction Co. Inc., of Hesston, is the primary contractor for the \$1,393,896 project.
