Survey for proposed U.S. 56 expressway at Great Bend to begin

A field survey for building a proposed four-lane expressway from the east side of Great Bend will start around Monday (Feb. 1).

The proposed expressway would be from the east city limits of Great Bend (Kiowa Road) to the K-156/K-96 junction. The approximate length of the survey is 2.3 miles, and the survey will be based on existing alignment.

This project is part of the Eisenhower Legacy Transportation (IKE) Program. The project is in the development phase. There is no project schedule at this point.

The survey, to collect information for detailed design of the proposed improvement, is estimated to be completed by May 1.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.


