

Guard rail repair and pothole patching in Topeka

The Kansas Department of Transportation will conduct several maintenance projects in Topeka this week, weather permitting.

- Thursday, April 15 The 10th Street on ramp and acceleration lane to eastbound I-70 at mile marker 363 will be closed from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Crews will be finishing guard rail repairs at the railroad bridge before the Adams off ramp.
- Friday, April 16 Crews will be patching potholes on the Oakland Expressway (K-4) and N.W. Seward Avenue ramps in northeast Topeka from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Minimal traffic interference is expected.
