Overhead sign replacement on I-70 in Topeka

Contractors are expected to begin replacing overhead signs on I-70 in Topeka, weather permitting Tuesday, April 20, through Friday, April 23, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

- Tuesday, April 20 –The eastbound and westbound left lanes on I-70 between SE Croco Road to Adams Street will be closed.
- Wednesday, April 21–The westbound right lane on I-70 will be closed between West 1st Avenue to U.S. 75.
- Thursday, April 22, and Friday, April 23–The westbound right lane on I-70 will be closed between U.S. 75 to I-470.

All the closures will take place from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Signs and cones will direct traffic through the work zone. Collins & Herman of Kansas City is the primary contractor.
